1- Task One

2 marks for each correct answer (2 x 8= 16 marks)

example: C

2- Task Two

2 marks for each correct answer (2 x 7= 14 marks)

(Pictures 1-5 on the left and 6-10 on the right)

Example: Mrs Brown	7 (cheese)
1. Jack	5 (spider)

3. Mr Brown	10 (chocolate)
4. Ben	6 (book)
5. Anna	3 (sunglasses)
6. Barry	2 (toy train)
7. Chantal	4 (a small notebook computer)

Distractors: 1 and 9

3- Task Three

2 marks for each correct answer (2 x 5= 10 marks)

Example: Do you like your school, Chantal? Yes, it's great.

1. Can you walk to school?
No, it's a long way from my house.
2. What's your favourite lesson?
English of course. The teacher is very good.
3. Are you good at maths?
Yes, but it's not my favourite subject.
4. Is your school for boys and girls?
No, it's just for girls.
5. How many lessons are there in a school day?
Three in the morning and three after lunch.

Distractor: **There are lessons each day.**

4- Task Four

2 marks for each correct answer (2 x 5= 10 marks)

(Pictures 1-3 on the left and 4-6 on the right)

Pic 1 It's five pounds for you and two pounds for a child. (Example)

Pic 2 Can you take a photo of me please?

Pic 3 Have some cake. I've got lots.

Pic 4 There are lots of people here. Let's come back later.

Pic 5 They are here, next to the tigers.

Pic 6 Look. We can sit there.

Distractor: This is a photo of a snake.

5- Task Five

2 marks for each correct answer (2 x 8= 16 marks)

Example - table

1- pencil

2- rabbit

3- burger

4- money

5- clock

6- window

7- chicken

8- sweatshirt

Distractors: the words '**duck**' and '**shorts**'

6- Task Six
